Workshop on Baba Sahab Dr. Bhimrao Ambedkar: The founder of Modern India

He added that social justice is the spirit and vision of the Indian Constitution. It is the duty of the state to secure a social order in which the legal system of the nation promotes justice on the basis of equal opportunity and, in particular, ensures that opportunities for securing justice are not denied to any citizen by reason of economic or other disabilities.
