


Mahatma Gandhi Shati Smarak Mahavidyalay

On January 23, 2023, the Department of Political Science, Mahatma Gandhi Shati Smarak Mahavidyalaya Garua Maksudpur, Ghazipur organized a Guest lecture on the theme of "The contribution of Subhash Chandra Bose in Indian Independence Movement: A Remembrance". This Lecture was dedicated to the contribution and sacrifice of Netaji Subhas Chandra Bose, one of the greatest symbols of Indian nationalism and struggle against colonialism.

The head of the Department of Hindi and the incumbent Principal Shri Sushil Tiwari made the ceremonial welcome of the guest speaker. Mr. Vashistha Kumar, Assistant Professor has been the key resource person for this guest lecture. He commenced this lecture by throwing light on early life history of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose. He further highlighted the contributions of Netaji that the participation of Subhash Chandra Bose took place with the Civil Disobedience Movement. This is how Subhash Chandra Bose became part of the Indian Independence movement. He became a member of the Indian National Congress (INC). Also, in 1939 he became the party president. However, this was for a short time only because of his resignation from this post. He took note of the role played by the Netaji in the liberation of India.

Mr. Ramashankar another speaker laid emphasis on the Bose's ideology tilted towards socialism and leftist authoritarianism. Mr. Ramashankar said that he formed the AllIndia Forward Bloc in 1939 as a faction within the Congress. At the start of the Second World War, Bose protested against the government for not consulting Indians before dragging them into the war.



Mr. Nitesh expressing his views stated that Bose believed that authoritarianism could bring liberation and reconstruction of Indian society.
